
NAMING DEVICES







When deploying **IQ**[™] devices, once paired, each device requires a name and number. The location field is not mandatory and does not play a role in the ordering of devices within the app. It is important to know that the way you name and number the devices will impact the way they are displayed in the Device List view.


The devices will first be ordered alphabetically by the device name and then numerically. Therefore, if you have devices you want to show up in a certain order you would want to name them the same name and let the system auto-tick up to the next number.

In this example you will find that the multi catch units show up in order Multi Catch 001 & Multi Catch 002. This is because they are named the same. However, the bait station trays are not listed together because one is named "bait tray" and the other is named "tray". The first one would fall under "Bs" where the second would be listed under "Ts".



If you choose to name your devices using numbers, it's imperative to use three digits. If you name a device using only one or two digits it will not show up in order.

In this example you can see that the device labeled "x1 001" is displayed after "x002 002" since on the first there is only one digit and on the second there are two.



In this example the correct labeling is shown with both devices named using three digits.
